Healthy Opportunities Pilot (HOP) Provider Website Resources

The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) approved up to [\$650] million in state and federal Medicaid funding to cover the cost of providing select pilot services that address non-medical drivers of health in four priority domains: housing, food, transportation, and interpersonal violence/toxic stress.

This pilot is focused on testing and evaluating the impact of nonmedical interventions related to social drivers of health to high-need Medicaid beneficiaries.
