

Provider News: Early Elective Delivery New Claim Submission Process

Beginning June 1, 2022, your health plan will be implementing a new Early Elective Delivery (EEDs) claim submission process, which will capture *non-medically* necessary EEDs and, at the same time, distinguish uncomplicated spontaneous labor/vaginal deliveries at 37 to 38 weeks' gestation. This new process will allow claims for deliveries precipitated by spontaneous labor and resulting in a delivery less than 39 weeks to be more efficiently and clearly identified.
